This year all employers must switch to SuperStream

By 1 July 2016, all employers must meet the Government's new minimum data standards when providing information to super funds.

Employers must also provide contribution data online. Emailed data can no longer be accepted. This means:

- No more cheques.
- No more paper instructions.
- No more emailed instructions.
- Potential penalties from the ATO for companies that don't comply.
